Volunteer Position Description

Position title:	Exhibits Coordinator
Purpose of the position:	To coordinate all exhibit potentials for LOVE youths' photography and writing, and put exhibit ideas into reality.
Responsibilities & activities:	Volunteers will organize exhibit materials, locate appropriate exhibit sites, coordinate exhibits (keep records of locations, contact names, dates of exhibits, dates for set up and break downs), and coordinate advertising. Will work with LOVE's Executive Director to ensure promotional materials ready to go with exhibits and coordinate with LOVE's Photojournalism Coordinator to ensure exhibit materials are available for exhibits. Will help in creating volunteer adult - LOVE youth teams and train them in soliciting venues and organizing photo selections, event details, etc...
Skills, experience, qualifications required:	Volunteers should have skills in organization, strategy planning and communications; Have or be willing to develop contacts in the art, café and gallery communities.
Personal traits / qualities desired:	Great written and verbal communication ability expected; Open-mindedness, flexibility, and connections with the community are a good asset to have. Also have an interest in LOVE's mission of empowering youth towards non-violence.
Orientation & training:	Orientation to Leave Out Violence (LOVE)'s programming will be given, and an on-site visit to the programs would be available; Will coordinate with LOVE's Photojournalism Coordinator to build on past LOVE exhibits and community contacts.

Support, supervision & evaluation provided:	This position will be working with the LOVE's Photojournalism Coordinator, who has many connections to Vancouver's art & photography communities.
Time commitment:	5 to 10 hours per month; with a minimum one year commitment.
Working conditions:	Can be done from home or arranged to work part-time on-site.
Benefits to volunteer:	In working on the Leave Out ViolencE (LOVE)'s Exhibits Project you will gain exposure to non-profit management, community coordination, networking, impact of art on humanity, gallery management skills, promotional skills, communication skills: all of which can build your resume and a legacy at LOVE BC.
# Volunteers Required	2 to 4 volunteers.
Screening measures:	Criminal Record Check (mandatory for working with youth); Access to a motor vehicle that can be used to transport exhibit materials highly recommended; Resumé.
