### **Volunteer Position Description**

<b>Position title:</b>	<b>Graphic Designer</b>
<b>Purpose of the position:</b>	Design for all marketing and communications materials for Leave Out Violence (LOVE) BC as required.
<b>Responsibilities &amp; activities:</b>	To work with the Executive Director to create all public relations material for this non-profit that empowers at-risk youth to advocate non-violence in their community. This includes formatting layout for fund development & donor recognition pieces, advertising, desktop publishing, etc...
<b>Skills, experience, qualifications required:</b>	Experience with desktop publishing software required; Having access to good hardware and software required for design work is recommended. Connections to the Vancouver printing industry would be appreciated. Ability to mentor LOVE youth who are interested in graphic design is an asset.
<b>Personal traits / qualities desired:</b>	Graphic designers need to be motivated, creative and imaginative. They should also be accurate, able to accept criticism and able to work well under pressure. Volunteers should be skilled in computer-aided design and interpreting LOVE's mission and values. They also need to have good communication skills, problem-solving skills and an eye for detail. An interest in empowering youth toward non-violence is key.
<b>Orientation &amp; training:</b>	Orientation to LOVE's current marketing material & programming will be given, and an on-site visit to the programs would be available.

<b>Support, supervision &amp; evaluation provided:</b>	This position will be working with the Executive Director to develop cohesive style and messaging for LOVE.
<b>Time commitment:</b>	5 to 10 hours per month as needed; with a minimum one year commitment.
<b>Working conditions:</b>	Can be done from home or arranged to work part-time on-site.
<b>Benefits to volunteer:</b>	Graphic Design volunteer will gain exposure to non-profit management, community coordination, networking, impact of art on humanity, promotional skills, communication skills: all of which can build your resume and a legacy at LOVE BC.
<b># Volunteers Required</b>	1 volunteer needed.
<b>Screening measures:</b>	Criminal Record Check (mandatory for working with youth); Resumé and sample work.
