Volunteer Position Description

Position title:	Special Project Coordinator ~ LOVE BC Calendar Project
Purpose of the position:	To help build and promote the non-profit organization by helping in the creation of a Leave Out Violence (LOVE) BC 2007 calendar, which includes all youth photograph's and writing from the Photojournalism class.
Responsibilities & activities:	You will work hand-in-hand with the youth to create an amazing Leave Out Violence (LOVE) BC 2007 calendar by late August 2006.
Skills, experience, qualifications required:	Volunteers should have good creativity skills, organizational skills, personal desire, commitment, communication ability, computer knowledge, and to be able to work well with others. Experience in either desktop publishing or corporate relations/fundraising AND willingness to learn and mentor both to a LOVE youth volunteer.
Personal traits / qualities desired:	Interest in empowering youth towards non-violence, and be a leader to encourage others in the creation of the calendar; the ability to accept constructive criticism is an asset.
Orientation & training:	Training will be given in any fundraising, corporate relations and desktop publishing tasks that are required by this project. Orientation to Leave Out Violence (LOVE) BC's programming will be given, and an on-site visit to the programs would be available.

Support, supervision & evaluation provided:	The position would work with LOVE's Executive Director to build a project outline, and would entitle you to mentor LOVE youth who have volunteered to help you with this project.
Time commitment:	10 to 20 hours per month for 6 months (or until complete); this includes scheduling time to work with LOVE youth volunteers on a regular basis to complete this project.
Working conditions:	Can be done from home or arranged to work part-time on-site.
Benefits to volunteer:	In working on the Leave Out Violence (LOVE)'s 2007 calendar the volunteer will gain mentoring, sales, marketing, print production, and first-hand experience working with LOVE youth.
# Volunteers Required	1- 2 volunteers.
Screening measures:	Criminal Record Check (mandatory for working with youth); Resumé, as well a writing or desktop publishing sample of your creativity.
