## Volunteer Position Description

<b>Position title:</b>	<b>Corporate Liaison &amp; Sponsorships Coordinator</b>
<b>Purpose of the position:</b>	To help build and maintain relationship with potential corporate funders to Leave Out Violence (LOVE) BC.
<b>Responsibilities &amp; activities:</b>	Work with the Executive Director to help build networks with corporate 'community funders' on behalf of LOVE BC. Includes building and executing corporate marketing strategies & solicitation plans. Build sponsorship potentials for various LOVE events and programs.
<b>Skills, experience, qualifications required:</b>	Volunteers should have good written and verbal communication skills and also be familiar with financial statements and revenue allocation. A demonstrated ability to present yourself in a professional manner and maintain confidentiality, manage multiple projects simultaneously, have or be able to develop corporate contacts, and have an interest in confidently representing LOVE's mission and values.
<b>Personal traits / qualities desired:</b>	Interest in empowering youth towards non-violence and the ability to tell LOVE's story descriptively; Demonstrates commitment and ability to follow through on tasks given; Self-motivated and interested in becoming part of a dynamic non-profit team.
<b>Orientation &amp; training:</b>	Training on corporate relations, researching development opportunities, and online profiling research can be provided by the Executive Director; Orientation to LOVE's programming will be given, and an on-site visit to the programs would be available.

<b>Support, supervision &amp; evaluation provided:</b>	This position would work with the Executive Director to establish goals and outcomes evaluation.
<b>Time commitment:</b>	5 to 10 hours per month; with a minimum one year commitment.
<b>Working conditions:</b>	Can be done from home or arranged to work part-time on-site.
<b>Benefits to volunteer:</b>	Experience in developing successful corporate sponsorship packages, building corporate-nonprofit partnerships, working with youth, involvement with a non-profit organization, and building a legacy at LOVE BC.
<b># Volunteers Required</b>	1 or 2 volunteers.
<b>Screening measures:</b>	Demonstrated writing and public relations skills; Resumé; Criminal Record Check (mandatory for working with youth).
